



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND PERMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES

- I understand that even with proper supervision, use of the equipment and workshop activities have some risk, and therefore the company, and its employees are not liable for risk. I hereby consent to my child's participation in the NMSC Eureka! SPRING Camp and do forever release, acquit, discharge, and covenant to hold harmless The National Mathematics and Science College, and their respective officers, employees, agents, affiliates, representatives, and assigns from any and all actions, causes of action, and claims that may arise on account of, or in any way growing out of, directly or indirectly, all known and unknown personal injuries or property damage which I as a parent or legal guardian or my child may have or hereafter acquire as a result of my child's participation in the NMSC Eureka! Spring Camp.
- I hereby grant permission for the camp administration to take necessary steps to obtain emergency medical care, if warranted in the opinion of the camp administration. These steps may include the following:
 - attempts to contact parent or guardian,
 - attempts to contact persons listed on the registration form.
 - If I or the persons listed cannot be reached, the camp administration will call the paramedics or an ambulance, if so warranted in the opinion of the camp administration.
 - I understand and agree that any expense incurred will be my responsibility.

Media Release

- I hereby authorise and grant full permission to NMSC Spring Camp to publish and copyright all photographs, video and other media in which my child appears while enrolled in a the NMSC Spring Camp. I agree that NMSC Spring Camp may use, in whole or in part, photographs, video, writings, drawings, creations, voice recordings of programme participants for activities including but not limited to publications, websites, staff training, curriculum development and marketing. I affirm that I have the legal right to grant this permission. If such is not consented to, I will indicate in my registration in a comment field or in writing be email.

Participant Code of Conduct

- In order for all young learners to have a safe and enjoyable time, participants must demonstrate good behaviour. Parents must review the following behaviour expectations and consequences with their child prior to the start of the NMSC Spring Camp
- **I agree that I understand the behaviour expectations and consequences and that I have reviewed these with my child.**
- Participant must take responsibility for his/her actions and abide by programme rules and policies.
- Participant must treat the programme leaders and teachers and participants with respect, kindness, and honesty.
- Participant must listen attentively to teachers and leaders.

- Participant must show support and compassion for other participants by listening, encouraging and helping them during programme activities.
- Participant should be fair when playing games; show good sportsmanship.
- Participant should ask teachers and leaders for help if he/she feels unable to meet these expectations.
- Participant must always try his/her best and have fun in ways that are safe for them and others.
- Except when excused by the programme teacher or leader, all participants are expected to remain at their designated area.

Should negative behaviour occur, NMSC Spring Camp will apply the following sanctions:

- **First Occurrence:** A quiet, verbal reprimand
- **Second Occurrence:** Verbal warning to participant and a phone call to parent or guardian
- **Third Occurrence:** Parent or guardian will be notified in writing via email.
- If the inappropriate behaviour continues beyond the written warning, the participant will be asked to leave for the remainder of the programme with no refund of already collected fees.
- If the offense is severe including, but not limited to, fighting, theft, vandalism, possession of weapons, alcohol, cigarettes, or illegal substances, inappropriate language, severe verbal threats, physical aggression, leaving the designated area without permission, or sexual misconduct, the participant will be **immediately dismissed** from the programme, bypassing all steps above, and **NO REFUND will be given. The actions taken will be at the discretion of the NMSC Spring Camp programme director.**
- There will be **no refunds** if a programme participant is temporarily or permanently suspended or dismissed from a programme due to failure to follow the code of conduct.

Refund Policy

- All refund requests must be submitted in writing and may be sent to NMSC via email.
- **AED 250 per child is a non-refundable deposit** and will not be returned for any reason.
- **No Shows:** No refund, credit or transfer is provided for a child who misses parts of the programme or doesn't come to the programme for any reason.
- If unforeseen conditions including but not limited to extreme weather conditions, outages and epidemics cause NMSC Spring Camp to shut down its camp for any length of time, no tuition will be refunded, credited or transferred.
- If a programme week is cancelled due to less than the minimum number of required registrations, NMSC will provide 100% refund of deposit, only in case of such a cancellation.
- There will be no refunds if a programme participant is temporarily or permanently suspended or dismissed from a programme due to failure to follow the code of conduct (see Code of Conduct above).
